

Ozemee Hotard

April 19, 1934, Mr. and Mrs. Ozemee Hotard of Reserve celebrated their golden-wedding anniversary. They renewed their vows of marriage at 6:30 a.m. in St. Peter's church. Mr. Hotard was 72 years old at the time, and Mrs. Hotard was 69. They have spent the greater part of their married life on sugar plantations where Mr. Hotard always served as field manager. Their union has been blessed with four children – Etienne and Emile of Reserve, and Ozemee of Raceland [only 3 children listed] – and there are fifteen grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. A picture of Mr. and Mrs. Hotard, Mrs. Jules J. Haydel, mother of Mrs. J. J. Millet, a daughter of Mrs. Hotard's, and little Marietta Millet, who represents the fourth generation of the Hotard family is included in the book.

Both Mr. and Mrs. Hotard, as well as all their children and grandchildren, are faithful members of the Church and are devout Catholics.
